

# AUDIENCE INFORMATION

To insure that each patron has the best concert experience he or she can, please take a moment to read the following information.

- Plan to arrive on time. If you do arrive after the performance has begun, ushers will wait to seat you until a break in the program.
- Please turn off all electronic devices that are not medically necessary. This includes but is not limited to cell phones, beepers, Blackberries, etc. The Alberta Bair Theater offers an emergency phone service for use with babysitters and others who may need to reach you.
- If you wear a hearing device, please turn down the volume so that it doesn't squeal during the performance.
- Any and all recordings of performances are prohibited. This includes use of cameras (with or without flash) camcorders, audio recorders, cell phones or any other electronic device.
- While you never want to leave during a concert performance, emergencies can occur. If at all possible, wait to exit the hall at a break in the performance (there is always a 20 minute intermission at season concerts) or during a moment where it will not interfere with the overall performance.
- Talking or rustling around during a performance keeps others in the audience from both hearing and enjoying the particular event they have chosen to attend. Such activities can also distract the performers, interfering with the overall performance.

- Applause is usually held until the end of each selection or until the end of the entire performance, when the conductor turns toward the audience and bows.
